Music and Movement Mondays

Our program will embrace a child's natural drive to observe, wonder, and discover their world. Over the course of our morning, we will encourage the children to test their ideas and concepts through the wonderful world of science and the use of simple yet entertaining experiments. Early Learning Playgroup

It is a free inclusive program for families and caregivers with children from birth to six years old. This environment provides a welcoming setting where you and your child can participate in play- and inquiry-based activities to support early learning and development.
